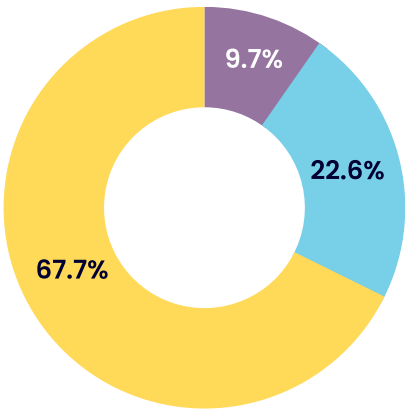

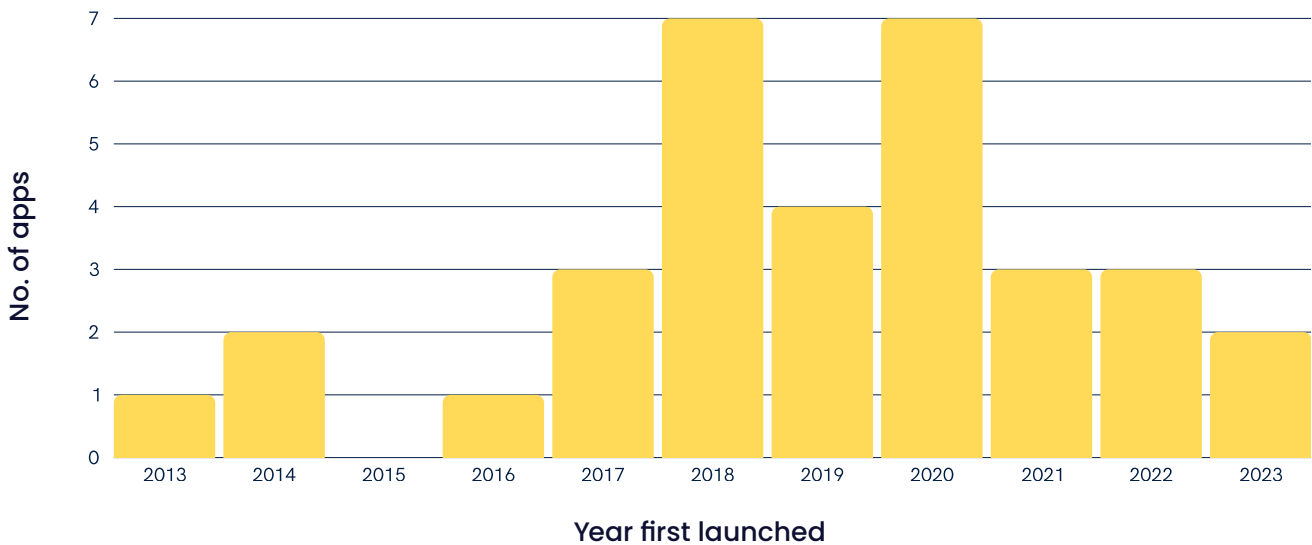

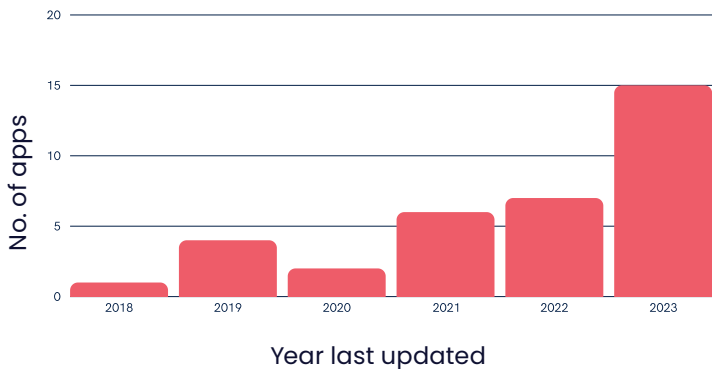
A Look at Recent App Launches and Updates



The legal sector, from 2013 to 2023, has shown an evolution in response to the requirement for digital solutions for emergency management for clients. The early years were marked by cautious exploration, however, from 2016 onwards, there was a gradual increase in app launches, indicating growing recognition of the importance of digital tools in emergency management.

This trend peaked in 2018, with a slight dip in 2019. The years 2020 and 2021 saw a resurgence in app development, aligning with the COVID-19 pandemic, highlighting the critical role of digital solutions in managing client crises. This period marked a shift towards enhancing the quality of existing apps rather than introducing new ones. The stabilization in app launches in 2022 and 2023 suggests a mature market focusing on refining and updating existing applications, as can be seen in the chart below.

App Update Trends in the Last 10 Years



Starting modestly with one app update in 2018, there has been a steady rise each year, reaching a peak of 15 updates in 2023. This trend highlights an industry focus on enhancing and refining existing applications, indicating a commitment to continuous improvement and adaptation to the increasing needs in emergency management for clients.

Data Breach 72 is an App developed by the law firm Baker McKenzie to support data controllers in the event of a data breach and help them comply with the provisions provided for this purpose by the General Data Protection Regulation. data (GDPR).

In a few clicks, Data Breach 72 offers the possibility:

- to identify the existence of a data breach within the meaning of the GDPR;
- to determine whether it is necessary

to notify the competent supervisory authority (the CNIL in France) within the legal period of 72 hours;

- prepare and share a first draft that can serve as a basis for this notification.

Data Breach 72 makes it possible to follow, in real time, the passage of time remaining for the company having become aware of the incident before having to officially notify it to the CNIL (within 72 hours maximum).



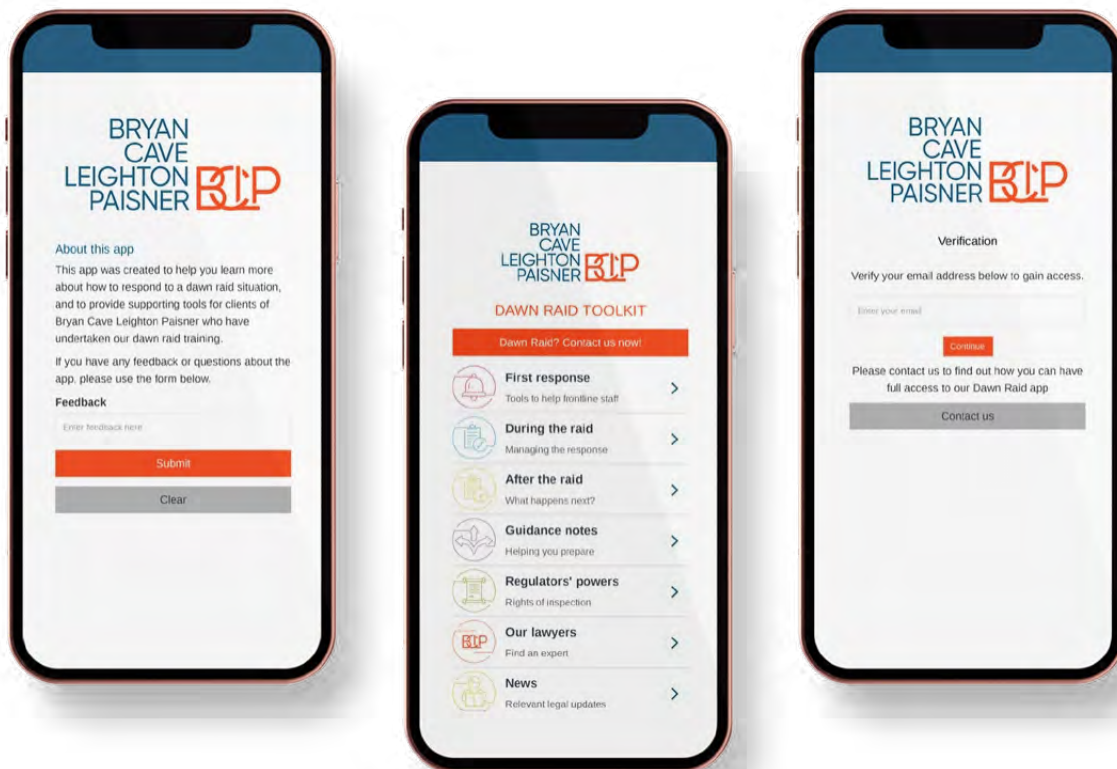
